Your comments:	<p>There are so many reasons why I am objection including -</p> <p>Noise and light pollution from the site, vibrations during nearly two years of drilling, noxious gases & smells released which would be unpleasant for local residents</p> <p>Huge increase in traffic both from site workers, equipment and supplies deliveries so would be a mix of private & contractor vehicles & HGVs</p> <p>Harmful diesel pollution along the whole route, including through Hull or Beverley</p> <p>and increased traffic leading to decrease in road safety along the route</p> <p>Pollution caused by gas venting & flaring: all gas found will be treated as waste and flared off</p> <p>But my the key grounds for my objection is on Climate change: the release of methane (an extremely potent greenhouse gas), and carbon dioxide (CO2)</p> <p>It has been calculated that the development alone would result in 200,000 tonnes of CO2 equivalent greenhouse gas pollution. And this development is incompatible with the move towards net zero cabin emissions - we should be cleaning up our act on the environmental front and any fossil fuels remaining should be left in the ground and the future focus be on renewable energy sources and sustainable alternatives for other industrial uses of fossil fuels.</p>
