should the expansion of the West Newton site go ahead is beyond ridiculous. Up to 25 Tankers passing my house every day for the estimated 20 years of production! Not to mention the 30 HGV's per day for 12 weeks of construction, an HGV every 12 minutes, 12 hours per day! I not only use this road to drive on. I regularly walk along the footpath and the roadside on my daily walks. The increased traffic would lead to a greater risk to pedestrians and road users alike.

I would also like to add that this being a rural community there are several properties with horses, and the roads are regularly used by horse riders. The proposed increase in traffic would also propose an additional danger to them. My granddaughter is a trainee nurse and regularly rides around the area on her horse. The potential risk to not only one highlighted young persons life, a young woman, a key worker, and a sentient animal only go to prove a point. There are many hundreds of other local road users. An increase in perceived risk is totally unacceptable.

The air pollution also plays heavily on my mind. People suffering from chest complaints will increase considerably. Medical services are already stretched due to the recent pandemic and lack of funding available. To put even more strain on medical providers would push them to point where they are unable to cope.

I am aware that should the proposal go ahead there will be a detrimental impact on local wildlife and a lasting impact on the environment. Our wildlife is already under threat due to global warming. To pose even more of a threat to depleting habitats is highly objectionable. The general pollution from noise, light, noxious odours, fumes and vibrations will lead to the destruction of the little bit of green and pleasant area that we have left in Holderness.

A climate emergency has been declared both nationally and locally and we should be looking for green renewable energy and not drilling for new sources of fossil fuels.

I most strongly object to the proposal. To go ahead with the plans would be a travesty of the highest order. All down to the greed of the large corporations with no thought for the individual needs of the population or the

continuation of the planet.
