**Your comments:**

Every National Government Policy and International Organisation concerning pollution and global warming have adopted every conceivable policy and legislation for our future well being and that of our children and in our case our children's children, not only to reduce fossil fuels, but to totally eradicate the use of such fuels..

One example, the most recent presented by the Government is to ban all Gas operated Boilers within 5 years. Another is the time limit on oil driven cars.

This is testament to the continuing process of this and other suggested polices aimed at totally eradicating any form of fossil fuel driven power and the mining or recovery of such fuels as coal, oil or natural gas..

There are at present more than adequate supplies of both natural gas and oil. No shortage and enormous availability.

To argue the necessity to increase supply production in the case of West Newton, a green fields site with the increased problems, the likes of the spoiling of Green Belt locations, burn off pollution , greatly increased numbers of large commercial vehicles transporting what is considered an extremely dangerous volatile gas through small villages on country roads not suited to such transport and causing reduced speeds, which results in causing extra and excessive pollution which residents will be exposed to is contrary to all our aims of improving our own environment. This will include the increasing amounts of Asthma sufferers only reported on in this last few weeks of having increased dramatically.

These issues, although of great importance to our local people are secondary to the most important factor of all, Global Warning is here now and global warning is here to stay if we do nothing to support the total elimination of the use and the production of fossil fuels.

We are requesting our local authority not only refuse this application, but when possible, also adopt a policy of working toward a time when this site can be totally closed down.

We would also like to see our local authority adopt a specific charter of support to do all in their power themselves to pursue a more recognised policy of supporting all actions aimed at reducing the use of all fossil fuels wherever possible and a planned future timetable of total elimination of both use and their production..
