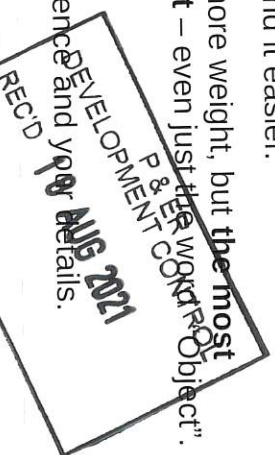
A letter in your own words may carry more weight, but **the most important thing is that you do object** – even just the words "Object".
